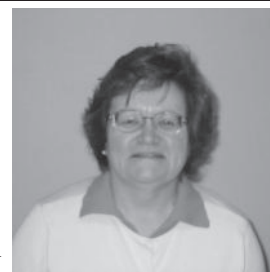

Our winter is over and our spring has finally arrived! This feast of Resurrection is the greatest feast of the church year. The gospel today is the original good news. Jesus of Nazareth, crucified, is risen and present with us. Christ's resurrection is victory over sin and death. Christ liberates the world and offers us a new day and a new life. Even after 2000 years, we still stand at the empty tomb filled with wonder and awe and surprise. In Christ's resurrection we are moved beyond the boundaries of human experience to the realms of divine love and life. Easter is our time to celebrate our faith in gratitude to Jesus Christ.

Our faith does not have to be perfect or without doubt to be true faith. Even the apostles had doubt. No one saw Jesus rise. Peter and others were eyewitnesses to an empty tomb. Everyone has to come to faith. Even the closest companions of Jesus were called to faith in the risen Lord. As individuals and as church, we move toward belief. It is always ahead of us. The disciples did not understand the resurrection, yet they believed.

We continue to ponder the meaning of resurrection in our lives and to ponder the mysteries of our faith. Through personal and communal prayer we grow closer to the Risen Christ.

We rejoice today and all days. He is risen! He is among us now! See and believe!

When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. - Jn 20:6-8

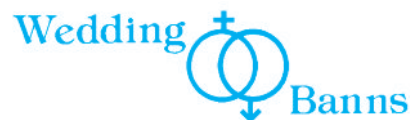
